

FINISHING SCHOOL PROGRAM

The **finishing school program** is introduced in polytechnics to make the students excel in industries by enriching their personality and social adaptation skills. The activities conducted under this program are orientation classes and seminars in the areas such as Interpersonal relationship, Career and Guidance, Communication English, Gender Equality, Time Management and Interview skills. Mock interviews & group discussions are also conducted. The endeavour is to train the students for competing in any field and to help them to analyse their SWOT (Strengths, Weakness, Opportunities and Threats) and to boost up their potential.

A Finishing School is defined as a school for students that emphasizes training in all round personality development, cultural and social activities etc. Specific skill-sets may be imparted as value addition. The name reflects that it follows the college education and is intended to complete the educational experience. All students, especially final year students, from all the six branches are automatically registered for the finishing school program. The classes are based on the Finishing School guidelines framed by the State Institute for Technical Teachers' Training and Research (SITTTR), Kalamassery.
