Introduction

Community Development Through Polytechnic (CDTP) is a skill development programme sponsored by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India. Government Polytechnic College, Palakkad has been successfully implementing this programme since 1993 with the objective of empowering the local community through vocational training.

Training Centres

The college operates one main training centre and seven sub-centres to effectively deliver CDTP activities. These centres ensure wider outreach and accessibility of skill training programmes to the surrounding community.

Courses Offered

The programme provides short-term training courses in welding, electrical wiring, plumbing, fruit and vegetable processing, tailoring, beautician training, book binding, electronics data entry, and repair of domestic appliances.

Faculty and Implementation

Experienced faculty members and technical staff of the institution serve as resource persons for the training programmes. Their expertise ensures quality training and practical skill development.

Funding and Beneficiaries

All CDTP courses are fully funded by the MHRD ministry, making them accessible to economically weaker sections. Approximately 700 youths are trained every six months, enhancing employability and self-employment opportunities.
