The Internet and Common Computing Facility (CCF) is a centrally managed facility established to provide advanced computing resources and reliable internet connectivity to students, faculty, and administrative staff.

Internet Connectivity

The facility is equipped with a high-speed BSNL broadband internet connection through Optical Fiber Cable (OFC), provided under the Continuing Education Cell scheme. This ensures uninterrupted and efficient internet access throughout the campus.

Computing Infrastructure

The Central Computing Facility has one of the best computing infrastructures in the region, equipped with modern computer systems and updated software. Internet facilities are extended to all departments, the library, faculty rooms, and administrative offices.

Academic Support

The CCF is dedicated to creating and maintaining a professional computing environment that supports academic learning and institutional activities. Students are encouraged to make effective use of the facility for academic purposes and to develop skills in modern computer applications and software technologies.
